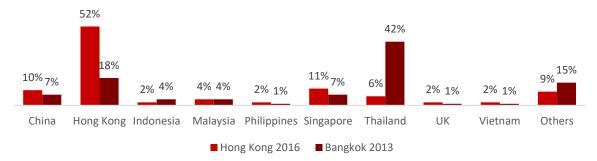
DELEGATE PROFILE

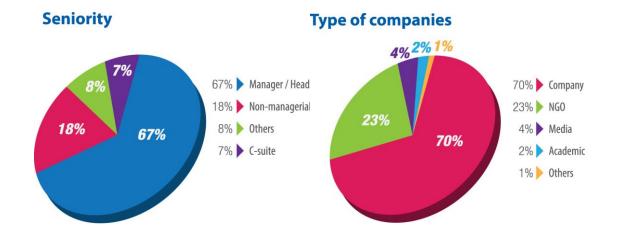
A GLOBAL AUDIENCE
