
Asia-Pacific's Progress towards Gender-Responsive NDCs





What is it?

The EmPower: Women for Climate- Resilient Societies Project published an interactive map that provides an overview of the level of gender integration in Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCs) and national climate policies in the Asia-Pacific Region. The map is based on the collaborative study conducted by UN Women, UNESCAP, UNEP, and the greenwerk entitled *Is* 1.5°C within Reach for the Asia-Pacific Region? Ambition and Potential of NDC Commitments of the Asia-Pacific Countries. The report provides a scenario-based assessment of the collective NDC commitments of countries in the Asia-Pacific Region, including individual commitments to action.

Why is it important?

The study has analyzed of 49 countries in the Asia-Pacific Region to understand the role of gender mainstreaming in enabling enhanced climate action. The map provides a snapshot of the countries' and the region's progress in mainstreaming gender in climate action. It offers insight into how the countries are integrating gender into their national climate policies and identifies key areas for progress.

Who is the map for?

The map is a tool intended for governments, donors, and civil society to enable them to monitor progress and effectively advance gender equality in climate policy and action. It is designed to be simple, accessible, and informative, providing relevant information to users.

How to use it?

The map shows 49 countries in the Asia-Pacific Region. It is color-coded based on the countries' progress on integrating gender in their climate policies.





Performance in integrating gender equality in climate policies



By clicking the location pin in each country, a quick summary of the country's performance on the key enabling factors will appear. A rating from 1 to 5 was given based on their performance on each of the following key factors: Mainstreaming Policies. Coordination Mechanisms, Climate Finance, and Monitoring and Transparency. Overall progress on gender equality is determined by the country's rating on the four factors and summarised into: Initiated, Progress, Effective, or Advanced. It will also show if the country has an appointed National Gender & Climate Change Focal Point (NGCCFP).
